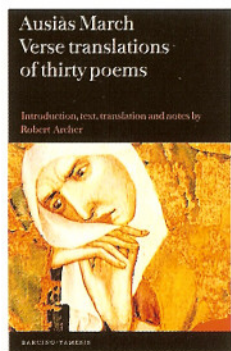

POETRY RECITAL AND BOOK PRESENTATION *Ausiàs March*. Verse translations of thirty poems.

Introduction, text, translation and notes by Robert Archer, Cervantes Chair of Spanish, King's College London.



*Ausiàs March (1400-1459)*

The presentation will be carried out by Carles Duarte i Montserrat (Fundació Carulla), Stephen Hart and Elspeth Ferguson.

**AUSIÀS MARCH** (Valencia, 1400-1459) is widely recognized as the greatest poet of medieval Spain. The recital will be given by the Valencian writer Víctor García Labrado, who will read March's poems in the original, and by Robert Archer of King's College London, who will read from his recent verse translations. The recital will be preceded by a presentation of the book, recently published by Tamesis and Fundació Carulla, from which the translations are taken.

**AUSIÀS MARCH** (Valencia 1400-1459) está reconocido como uno de los grandes poetas de la época medieval. El recital correrá a cargo del escritor valenciano Víctor García Labrado, que leerá algunos de los poemas en su lengua original y por Robert Archer del King's College de Londres, que leerá las traducciones. Antes del recital se presentará el libro recientemente editado por Tamesis y la Fundació Carulla.
